

Easter Duty:

Church law number 920 states: a) All the faithful, after they have been initiated into the Most Holy Eucharist, are bound by the obligation of receiving Communion at least once a year, b) This precept must be fulfilled during the Easter season unless it is fulfilled for a just cause at some other time during the year. Please note, however, that the United States has been granted an indult of extending the time for the annual reception of Holy Communion from the beginning of Lent through the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity (this year March 5 - June 15). An "indult" is a license granted by competent Church authority for an exception from a particular norm of Church law.

Sacrament of Confirmation:

The parish is happy to announce that Rachel Wilkins, a wife and mother of three children, celebrated the Sacrament of Confirmation at our parish Easter Vigil (April 19, 2025). Rachael's husband, Gregory, was her sponsor.
