



Children and Family Faith Formation:

Families with children in grades K-6 are invited to join our parish Family Faith Formation program. The program includes preparation for First Holy Communion and First Reconciliation. Children's Liturgy of the Word:

On the second Saturday of each month, children are invited to participate in the Children's Liturgy of the Word during the 4:00 p.m. Mass.

After the opening prayer, children are dismissed with their adult leaders to the Annex to hear and reflect on the readings in age-appropriate formats. As time permits, children engage in activities reinforcing the message of the readings such as singing songs, coloring, or acting out a skit. Children will return to their families during the offertory procession. The next gathering is on September 13th.

Confirmation Preparation & Adult Study:

Students in eighth grade and above who have not celebrated the Sacrament of Confirmation and adults desiring to celebrate Baptism, or Confirmation / First Holy Communion, and everyone desiring to know more about our faith are invited to attend classes on Saturdays (with one exception: the second Saturday of the month) at 5:15 5:00–6:15 p.m. in the St. Francis Solanus Annex. The first class is on September 20th.

Finance Council:

The Parish Finance Council met on August 11, 2025, among other agenda items, there was the review of the end of the fiscal year (June 30) Statement of Revenues and Expenditures. The fiscal year total operating revenue was \$270,594.05 and the total operating expenses were \$274,444.80 – leaving a deficit of \$3,850.75. The good news, the Sunday and Holy Day collections were \$8,000 up from the previous year. Regarding the St. James the Apostle and Holy Cross cemeteries, each cemetery averages an annual expense of \$20,000. An annual parish financial report of income and expenses and a balance sheet summary will be published and distributed the end of September.

Cemeteries:

The Parish of Mary, Mother of Mercy has two cemeteries, St. James the Apostle, Trumansburg, and Holy Cross, Ovid. To purchase the right to burial in a grave in the traditional part of the cemetery is \$900. To purchase the right to burial in the green section of St. James the Apostle cemetery is \$1,000. For the interment of a body in an already purchased plot is \$900 and for the interment of cremains in an already purchased plot is \$700. Regarding burials, between November 1 and April 1 there is an additional charge of \$100 and burials on any given weekend or holiday are an additional cost of \$250.

Sanctuary Lamp:

In the sanctuary, a candle called the "sanctuary lamp" is always lit to indicate that the Blessed Sacrament is present in the church. Every week the candle or oil is renewed. Parishioners may request that the sanctuary lamp be lit for the week for their intention. In an envelope specifying "sanctuary lamp," place a free will offering with your request and preferred week and church. This may be placed in the offering basket or mailed to the parish office.

Ithaca Peace Festival:

Please mark your calendars for September 12-14 as you won't want to miss the Ithaca Peace Festival at St. Catherine of Siena parish. This three-day event will include presentations on peace-making, music and dancing with Jorge T. 


