


2026 Calendars and Boxed Offering Envelopes:

2025-2026 Catholic Ministries Appeal (CMA)

On December 2, 2025, it was reported that seventy-six parish households have pledged \$29,740 to the CMA. This represents 92.94% of our given parish goal. (This year there is a Diocesan effort to increase the number of donors over CMA 24-25. The parish with the greatest percentage increase in number of donors will be awarded \$5,000.
