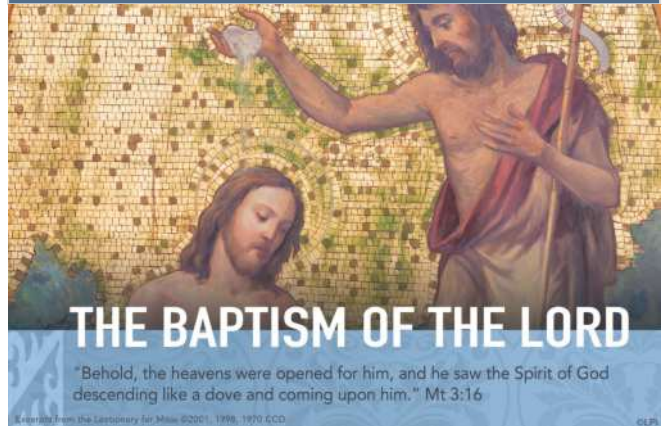

On Wednesdays following the 8:30 a.m. daily Mass at St. Francis Solanus, take time to connect with your fellow parishioners over a light breakfast in the Annex.

Catholic Ministries Appeal:

On December 30, 2025, it was reported that our parish has surpassed the given goal. Ninety-one parish households have pledged \$34,545 to the CMA. This represents 107.95% of our given parish goal. The parish goal was \$32,000 We thank those who have given generously. We encourage parish households who have not yet made a pledge to prayerfully consider doing so. After reaching our given parish goal, our parish will be given a rebate. The rebate is half the amount over goal. The CMA helps our Church and our parish. (This year there is a Diocesan effort to increase the number of donors over CMA 24-25. The parish with the greatest percentage increase in number of donors will be awarded \$5,000. For every parish that increased the number of donors by 10%+ over CMA24-25 will be awarded \$1,000.)

Food Pantries—Thank you:

In 2025, Mary, Mother of Mercy parishioners gave \$1,095 to our local food pantries. Thank you to all who donated. In this new year, may we remember our blessings and continue to share with our neighbors in need.

“SouperBowl” Sunday—February 8:

SouperBowl Sunday is a national ecclesiastical event. It draws attention to those experiencing the need for food in our communities. All food items gathered and funds raised in our parish go to the local food pantries located in Interlaken, Ovid, and Trumansburg.

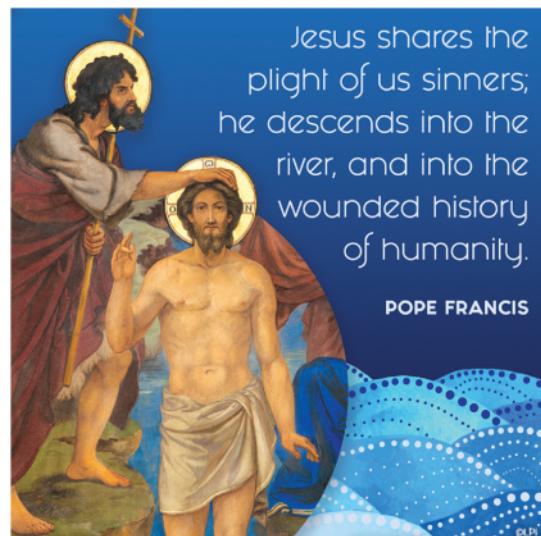
