
DIOCESE OF ROCHESTER – NEW BISHOP

On January 7, 2026, Pope Leo XIV appointed Bishop John Bonnici to succeed The Most Reverend Salvatore R. Matano as the Tenth Bishop of Rochester. Bishop Bonnici will be installed as the Bishop of Rochester on March 19, 2026, the Solemnity of St. Joseph.

Bishop Bonnici was born in New York City. He is 61 years old. He was ordained a priest in 1991 at St. Patrick's Cathedral, NYC. He was ordained a Bishop on March 1, 2022, by Cardinal Dolan as an Auxiliary Bishop of New York. In 1992, Bishop Bonnici earned a Licentiate of Sacred Theology Degree and in 1995 he earned the degree of Doctor of Sacred Theology. Bishop Bonnici has ministered as a parochial vicar, professor of theology, pastor of several parishes, and as Episcopal Vicar for Westchester and Rockland Counties. He also serves as a member of several national and diocesan committees. We welcome Bishop Bonnici to Rochester.

CATHOLIC MINISTRIES APPEAL:

On December 30, 2025, it was reported that our parish has surpassed the given goal. Ninety-one parish households have pledged \$34,545 to the CMA. This represents 107.95% of our given parish goal. The parish goal was \$32,000. We thank those who have given generously. We encourage parish households who have not yet made a pledge to prayerfully consider doing so. After reaching our given parish goal, our parish will be given a rebate. The rebate is half the amount over goal.

SOUPERBOWL OF CARING 2026

Sunday, February 8th, is Super Bowl Sunday, and across the nation it is also SouperBowl of Caring. The parish of Mary, Mother of Mercy will be participating in this one day event. The idea is to collect donations of non-perishable food items and cash that would go directly to the local food pantries in our parish.
