



Sweet Sunday:

This Sunday, and the first Sunday of every month, parishioners are invited to a social time following the 9:00 a.m. Mass at St. James the Apostle, Trumansburg and the 10:30 a.m. Mass at Holy Cross, Ovid.

Pentecost Sunday:

Next Sunday is Pentecost Sunday, the end of the Easter Season and the celebration of the followers of Jesus being gifted with the Holy Spirit. In keeping with the liturgical color of the day, everyone is invited to wear red articles of clothing when coming to Mass.

This Pentecost Sunday also concludes the three year National Eucharistic Revival. What continues is the mission of parishioners to invite Catholics to weekly celebrate the love and union with God through Jesus in the Sacrament of Holy Communion.

Cemetery Collection this Weekend:

Parish Census:

Remember last fall? the Diocese of Rochester promoted the updating of the parish census. Our parish secretary, Susan Guydosh, has done marvelous work in keeping our Parish Census updated while at the same time recognizing a need to acquire follow-up information.

The Diocese is sponsoring an informational and training opportunity to assist in implementation of the data obtained through the census. It will be held via Zoom at the parish center on Wednesday, June 25, 2025, beginning at 9:30 a.m. until 2:00 p.m. It would be good to have a parish team to help with the follow-up.

Eucharistic Holy Hour – Encounter Night:

June 22nd is the feast day of The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi). Our parish is having a Corpus Christi procession in keeping with the Church's sacred tradition throughout the world. The procession will begin at 4:00 p.m. on Sunday, June 22, at St. Francis Solanus Church, Interlaken.

Weather permitting, the procession will go outside. The procession will include three benedictions of the Blessed Sacrament with the singing of Eucharistic hymns and teachings of Jesus read from the Gospels.

A dish to pass social will follow in the St. Francis Solanus Annex.

Easter Duty:

Church law number 920 states: a) All the faithful, after they have been initiated into the Most Holy Eucharist, are bound by the obligation of receiving Communion at least once a year, b) This precept must be fulfilled during the Easter season unless it is fulfilled for a just cause at some other time during the year. Please note, however, that the United States has been granted an indult of extending the time for the annual reception of Holy Communion from the beginning of Lent through the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity (this year March 5 - June 15). An "indult" is a license granted by competent Church authority for an exception from a particular norm of Church law.
